

FEARFULLY & WONDERFULLY MADE

Psalm 139:13-16



-- v. 13 - *"For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb."*

- God creates every single person with the utmost attention, artistry, and purpose.
- Nothing people have created remotely compares to the miracle of **Life**.

-- v. 14

-- *"I praise you..."*

- Pondering the creation of life within the womb ought to inspire within us joyful, awestruck **Praise** of God.
- Who, upon observing the miracle of human creation, could not be flooded with awe, wonder, and delight in our Creator?
- *"...because I am fearfully and wonderfully made..."*
 - *"Fearfully"* - The awesome workmanship with which God has created us ought to inspire awe of Him.
 - *"Wonderfully"* - Our creation by God is immeasurably greater than anything we could even conceive.
- *"Your works are wonderful, I know that full well."*
 - David saw the **Glory** of God in the baby in the womb.
 - David knew God and stood in awe of the truth.

-- v. 15-16a - *"My frame was not hidden from you..."*

- God is intimately involved with and concerned about the **Unborn**.

-- v. 16b - *"All the days ordained for me..."*

- We exist as people created in God's image before we are even conceived (Jeremiah 1:5).
- Having lost the *Scientific* argument about when life begins, the pro-choice movement is revealing its true colors.

-- Quotes from Celebrated Abortion Advocate, Merle Hoffman

- *"The act of abortion positions women at their most powerful, and that is why it is so strongly opposed by many in society."*
- *"They knew [that abortion was the termination of a potential life], but my patients who made the choice to have an abortion also knew they were making the right one, a decision so vital it was worth stopping that heart... In the majority of cases, they felt a great sense of relief and the power that comes from taking responsibility for one's own life."*
