



-- **Big Idea:** The wrath of God is a vitally important doctrine in the church and in the world.

-- v. 14 -20

-- “\_SON OF MAN” is a reference to the prophesy given to Daniel in Daniel 7:13-14.

-- In the Gospels, Jesus describes Himself as the Son of Man who has come to earth to sow the seeds of the Gospel. Now, in Revelation 14, we see the Son of Man returning to reap the final harvest of His final judgment.

-- **Two Separate HARVESTA**

1.) v. 14-16 – This is the harvest of the good crops that will be gathered in the storehouse (heaven)

2.) v. 17-20 – This is the harvest of the bad crops that will be pressed in the winepress of God’s wrath (hell).

**1.) God’s wrath is TERRIFYING**

-- Joel 3:12-14, Isaiah 63:1-6, Hebrews 10:31

**2.) The wrath of God is UNDERESTIMATED**

-- Matthew 7:13-14, Matthew 7:21-23

### 3.) The wrath of God is **DESERVED**

Psalm 51:4, Romans 3:10-18.

### 4.) The wrath of God is **NEEDED**

-- The wrath of God is arguably the principal doctrine that keeps reckless evil at bay (Romans 2:5).

### 5.) God's wrath is **SATISFIED** in Christ.

-- 1 Timothy 1:15, 1 Peter 2:24, Romans 3:26

-- John Owen – “The purpose of our holy and righteous God was to save His church, but their sin could not go unpunished. It was, therefore, necessary that the punishment for that sin be transferred from those who deserved it but could not bear it, to one who did not deserve it but was able to bear it.”
