



Big Idea: Faith in Christ produces good works in us.

- Although our good works will never produce salvation, true salvation will always produce good works (Luke 13:6-9).

Luke 3:8-14

- If you have really repented, good works will result.
- Real repentance culminates in new **PATTERNS** of righteousness.

Ephesians 4:22-29

- Repentance is not just about stripping ourselves of sin; it is also means clothing ourselves in **RIGHTEOUSNESS**

John 15:1-6

- The longer we are connected to Christ by faith, the more we should resemble Him in life.
- If we are in Christ by faith, then the **LIKENESS** of Christ should be increasingly evident in who we are and what we do.

Titus Review

- v. 1:5-9 – A picture of a transformed life
- v. 1:10-16 – Habitually ungodly people are people without Christ.
- v. 2:1-10 – Sound doctrine leads to godly living among all believers, regardless of age or gender.
- v. 2:11-13 – The grace that saves us also **SANCTIFIES** us.
- v. 3:12 – A life of good works means making sacrifices for the blessing of others and going out of your way to meet them where they are.
- v. 3:13 – A life of good works means living to encourage others.
- v. 3:14 – It is good in God’s sight to help people in their moment of urgent need.
- Good works are words and actions that bring glory to God and blessings to people.
- The call to live out a **PRODUCTIVE** faith is a summons for the whole church, both then and now (Ephesians 2:10).
- The gifts God has given us have been given to us so that we might be productive members of the church of Jesus Christ for the glory of God (1 Peter 4:10-11, Gal. 6:9-10, 1 Cor. 14:12, 1 Cor. 3:10-15).
